

**HUALAPAI TRIBAL COUNCIL
RESOLUTION NO. _____
OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
HUALAPAI TRIBE OF THE HUALAPAI RESEVATION
PEACH SPRINGS, ARIZONA**

WHEREAS, the Hualapai Tribe is a federally recognized tribe exercising its powers of self-government through its Tribal Council;

WHEREAS, it benefits the Hualapai Tribe, State of Arizona and the First Things First Board to partner with tribal governments on improving early childhood and health opportunities for their youngest members, birth through five years; and

WHEREAS, the Hualapai Tribe has elected to form its own Regional Partnership Council under 2006 Proposition 203, Arizona Early Childhood Development and Health Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Hualapai Tribe understands that once the decision was made to form a local council, a local Regional Partnership Council was appointed and has responsibility for assessment, planning, partnership development, resource development and program/service implementation for early childhood development and health improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Partnership Council has responsibility for conducting an assessment every two years that will identify the assets available for early childhood development and health program in your region and based upon the information, identify and prioritized the unmet needs for early childhood and health needs; and

WHEREAS, a report will be prepared that will assist the Regional Partnership Council in developing a Funding Plan that will address the unmet needs and strengthen existing services for your community; and

WHEREAS, the First Things First Board and staff recognize a review process will be implemented by the tribe to further understand the purpose and benefits of the report; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Hualapai Tribe has established a review process and understands the Needs and Assets Report study, timeliness and purposes under First Things First and approves the undertaking of such report.
