OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
HUALAPAI TRIBE OF THE HUALAPAI RESERVATION
HUALAPAI TRIBAL COUNCIL

(First Things First (FTF) Hualapai Maternal Child Health Program)
(FTF Hualapai Regional Partnership Council Funds)

WHEREAS, the Hualapai Tribe has the health of the Hualapai people as a priority as demonstrated by their support of health promotion and education initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe approves the goal of maternal-child wellness; and

WHEREAS, understands that the period of life from prenatal through age five is a critical time for healthy growth and brain development; and

WHEREAS, the Hualapai Tribe's Departments have managed and implemented a number of grant/projects and have collectively seen the need for maternal-child support, education and advocacy in increasing parental awareness about early childhood development and guidance, access to screening, referral and services for children with special needs, decreasing child abuse and neglect and providing training needs for in-home providers; and

WHEREAS, supports the First Things First Hualapai Tribe Regional Partnership Council funded initiative for the Maternal-Child Health Program consisting of a Community Health Nurse and Maternal Child Advocate; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Hualapai Health Department will continue to support the Maternal-Child Health Program by providing space at the Health Department facility for a Community Health Nurse and Maternal Child Advocate; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hualapai Tribal Council approves the submittal of a grant renewal application to support and promote a healthy lifestyle for the prenatal through age five population of the Peach Springs community on the Hualapai Reservation, and authorizes the Chairman or Vice-Chairman to negotiate and execute any and all agreements and contracts pertaining to this grant.
