WHAT IS THE FIRST THINGS FIRST PINAL REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL HIGH RISK NEWBORN/INFANT HOME VISITATION GRANT PROGRAM?

The Pinal Regional Partnership Council has identified the need for regional implementation of the following strategy:

- Expand and build capacity of high-risk newborn/infant home visitation programs to provide family centered, culturally and developmentally appropriate coordinated home visiting services to infants and other children identified with special health care needs following admission to the Newborn Intensive Care Unit.

The intended target population of this funding opportunity is families with newborn or infants who reside or receive services within the boundaries described below. The programs targets 300 infants in the Pinal Region who spent 24 hours or more and/or were transported to a Newborn Intensive Care Unit immediately after birth due to prematurity and/or medical complications.

WHAT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDING AVAILABLE?

Approximately \$400,000 is available in this Request for Grant Application. Contract renewal will be contingent upon satisfactory contract performance, evaluation and availability of funds. The anticipated contract period for any resultant grant will be July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011.
