WHAT IS THE FIRST THINGS FIRST REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL

ORAL HEALTH GRANT PROGRAM?

The South Phoenix Regional Partnership Council (RPC) has identified the need for programs to increase children's access to preventive dental care. The Regional Council recognizes that there are various community partners conducting oral health screening, varnishing, education and outreach in the Phoenix region, so it is the expectation of the Regional Council that the grantee(s) work with current initiatives and organizations to ensure systemic approaches for the delivery of services to the target populations.

Additionally, the Regional Council, in an effort to continue to build collaboration and coordination of services, highly encourages applicants to consider the geographic size and possible reach of implementing services. Therefore, applicants are encouraged to demonstrate how: 1) partnerships will be established; 2) delivery of service will be managed across multiple zip codes; and 3) current resources will be leveraged to better enhance the use of First Things First funding for oral health screening and varnishing in the South Phoenix and Maryvale Regions. The council seeks either one administrative entity or a collaborative partnership that will address the activities outlined in the RFGA.

WHAT IS THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDING AVAILABLE?

This is a two (2) month contract with an option for renewal for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods. Total funds available on an annual basis are expected to be approximately \$450,000 with the understanding that a prorated amount of approximately \$75,000 will be available for the first two (2) month funding period. Contract renewal will be contingent upon satisfactory contract performance, evaluation and availability of funds.

The 2-month period is estimated to be May 1, 2011 through June 30, 2011. The 12-month period is estimated to be July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.
